Based on Andrew’s analysis of nearly 10,000 police reports from the scene of intimate partner violence incidents occurring in Indianapolis and his recent publications in the Journal of Interpersonal Violence, this presentation will describe the many specific emotional and physical risks of harm for all adults, children, and animals residing in violent homes. In addition to the extensive risks of harm for victims, concerns for the safety of first responders at the scene of these incidents and the need for more effective intervention programs for perpetrators will also be addressed. Effective multi-disciplinary strategies for reducing risk and improving outcomes in homes where these multiple forms of violence occur will be discussed.

Our Foster Pet Program helps victims leave their abusers. The program consists of volunteer host families who agree to temporarily house pets while the victim is fleeing or in transition from an abusive household. The program is available to domestic violence and sexual assault clients. Other domestic violence and sexual assault agencies and shelters refer their clients to us for this service. Additionally, this program focus’ on prevention education and pet abuse awareness explaining the link between animal abuse and domestic violence. Beacon of Hope is launching a Central Indiana Pet Abuse Link Task Force (PALTF), the task force includes and is open to Chiefs, Mayors, Attorneys, DVMS, Analysts and Domestic Abuse CEOs.
